Note: Parental Responsibility:

A mother automatically has parental responsibility for her child from birth.

A father usually has parental responsibility if he's:

- Married to the child's mother
- Listed on the birth certificate (after a certain date, depending on which part of the UK the child was born in)

Unmarried parents

An unmarried father can only get legal responsibility for his child in 1 of 3 ways:

- Jointly registering the birth of the child with the mother (from 1 Dec 2003)
- Getting a parental responsibility agreement with the mother
- Getting a parental responsibility order from the court

Same-sex parents

Same-sex partners who are civil partners will both have parental responsibility.
